Dan's Notes: Campbell Ranch lies in the heart of the West Sonoma Coast-- a complex appellation defined by the confluence of the Pacific tectonic plate and the North American plate with diverse soils, elevation and a dance of proximity to the cold Pacific waters. This rugged terrain offers tension and complexity, perfect for the delicate balance of Pinot Noir. Hints of cherry, black stonefruit, and cocoa are complimented by umami notes of shitake mushroom, anise and laurel.
