Dan's Notes: I have always thought that Garys' Vineyard was a statement of pioneering spirit in the ethos of California wine. Bold, dark, at times, but always emblematic of the families that farm the land. A stone's throw from Rosella's Vineyard, the Garys' Vineyard shows a completely different, patriarchal tone. Perhaps a result of its more southern and protected exposure, this wine shows a penetrating power on the palate with blackberry, cocoa and spice. With black and blue fruit, this wine is balanced with lavender and earth notes that offer nuance to an otherwise unapologetic wine.
