Dan's Notes: Campbell Ranch has held a very special place in my heart since 2013 when we used the fruit from the coastal vineyard for the first time. I've always been intrigued by the subtle complexity that the vineyard offers. 2021 was a fairly intense vintage, boasting broad red and black fruit. What is unique about this land-- other than the complex fruit-- are the savory undertones that make one think about the nuances of the wine and how fruit meets earth. Hints of pine needle and earthiness compliment the juicy complexity of the dark fruit, making for a profile that covers the entire palate through the long, dusty finish.
